The Bears of Blue River was written by Charles Major and published in 1901. Join us as we follow the adventures of Balser, the 13-year-old boy who lived in "a cozy log cabin of two rooms…on the east bank of the Big Blue River".

The drive will begin in Shelbyville, then proceed northeast toward New Castle. After lunch at the Wilbur Wright Birthplace Festival, where there will be remote control airplane demonstrations – helicopter rides – music – crafts – and a pork chop dinner, we will start back south to Warm Glow Candle Factory.

Warm Glow is located just off I70 in Centerville. We expect to be there around 2:00 and stay for about 45 minutes. If you need to leave the group, this is a good place to think about doing that. If you would like to join the group for the second half of the drive, this would be a good place for that.

Our drive will continue from Warm Glow at a leisurely pace, but then lookout for those snakes in the road as we find and follow Salt Creek to Oldenburg where we will end our day around 4:00.
