



# FAIR OAKS FARMS DRIVING TOUR



**RESCHEDULED! Saturday, Sept 16, 2017**

Come along as we travel from Zionsville to Fair Oaks Farms in Newton County. We will meet at the Zionsville Presbyterian Church at 9:00 AM, departure at 9:30. The Church is in the SE corner of Michigan Road (US 421) ad 116<sup>th</sup> Street, 2 miles north of I-465.

We will use County roads loosely following scenic and historic US 421 through Boone and Carroll Counties. In Carrol County we will stop by Lancaster Covered Bridge on CR 500W. We will continue northwest until we get to Fair Oaks Farms. It should be around noon then, so we can enjoy lunch at their wonderful restaurant and/or get some ice cream and look around their farm areas. Lunch run from about \$7 to \$15 for soups/salads, pizza, and sandwiches – with pricier items also on the menu. For those interested, various Farm “Adventures” are available at around \$15 for seniors or \$20 for adults.

The drive back offers some options.

1. You can retrace your drive north on the east side of I-65;
2. Jump on I-65 from SR 14 and return to Indy; or
3. Follow the group as we head southeast until we get to Fort Ouiatenon near West Lafayette. This is a reconstructed French Trading post from that was originally built in 1717. From there we will continue back to Indy.



Finally, I have been in contact with two other British Car Clubs (Michiana Brits Car Club and Northern Indiana British Car Club). They are hoping to meet up with us at noon so we can kick their tyres. I will be providing detailed driving maps the day of the drive.
