On November 14, 1896, the first London to Brighton Run was held in England to celebrate raising the speed limit from 4 to 14 mph. The Indiana British Car Union (IBCU) celebrates the 123rd anniversary of this event with its annual rally/tour across Indiana, for all British cars. The Hoosier MG's, in association with the IBCU rally/tour, is again hosting the Movie and Dinner before the London to Brighton Run - this year it will be the 1963 comedy "The Pink Panther", starring Peter Sellers, at the Royal Theatre in Danville, Indiana.

So - Interested in a dinner before the movie? Two local Danville restaurants (Frank's Place, Mayberry Café), have a special offer of a free (non-alcoholic) drink with the purchase of a dinner entrée at their establishment. Just show proof of British car ownership and you're in.

The movie runs 115 minutes and will start promptly at 7:00 pm on Thursday, June 6th. The Royal Theatre is located a short drive west of Indy just off SR36 in Danville (59 S. Washington St.).
